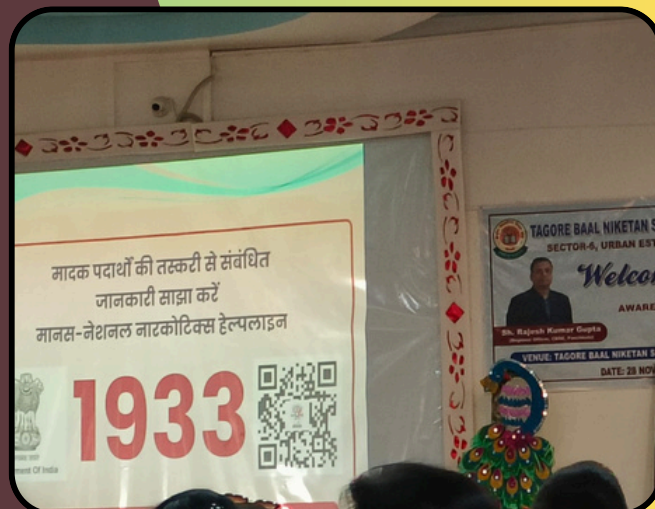

Children's Day Celebration

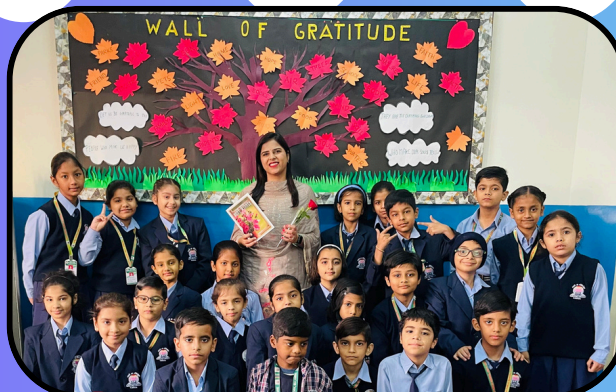

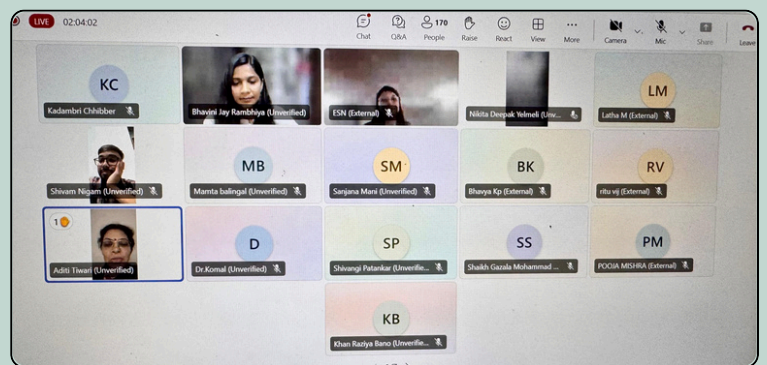
