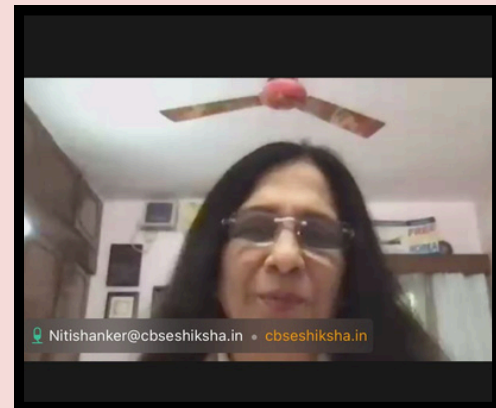
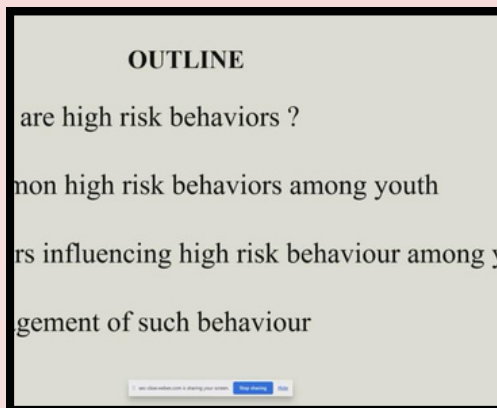
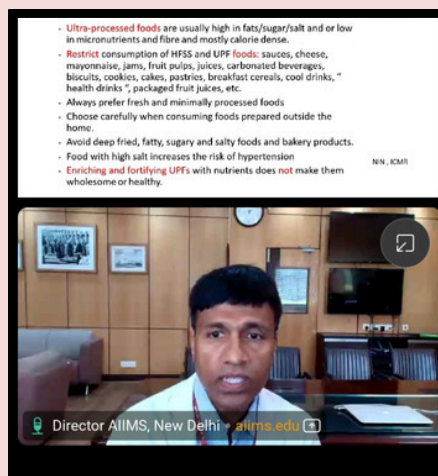
LET THE LIGHT OF DIWALI BRIGHTEN EVERY HEART
