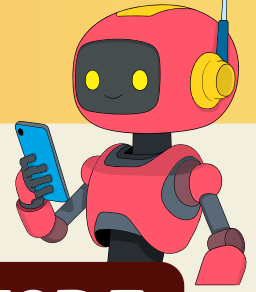

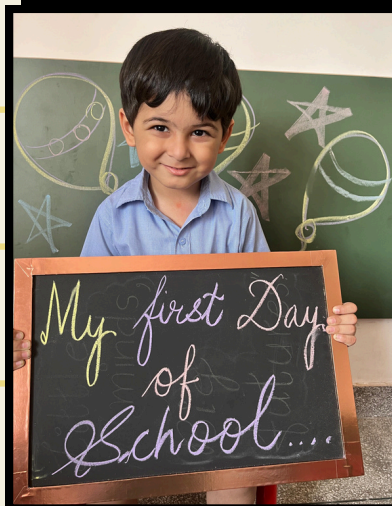
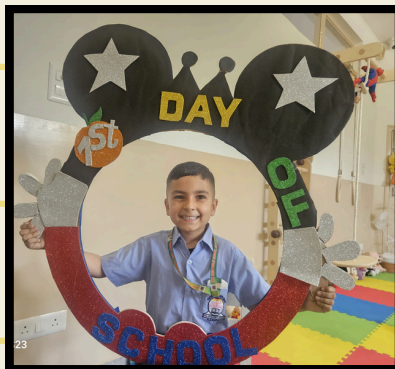
INTER-HOUSE DANCE COMPETITION – BAISAKHI CELEBRATION

EARTH DAY CELEBRATION

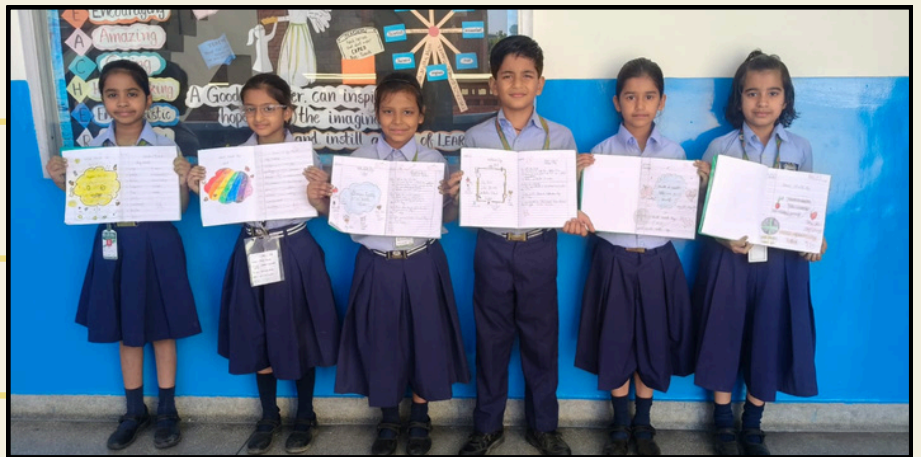

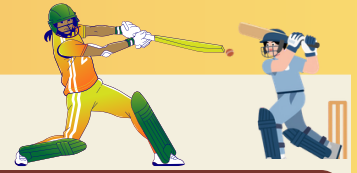
INTER-SECTION SALAD MAKING COMPETITION

PROUD ACHIEVEMENT IN THERESIAN CRICKET TOURNAMENT 2026

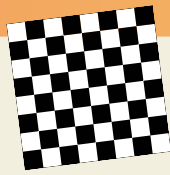

ENRICHING SESSION ON LEARNING PSYCHOLOGY

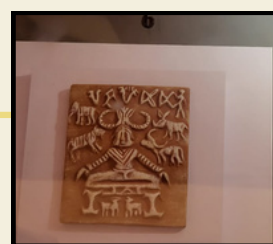

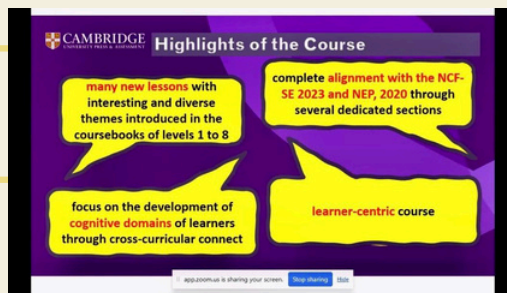

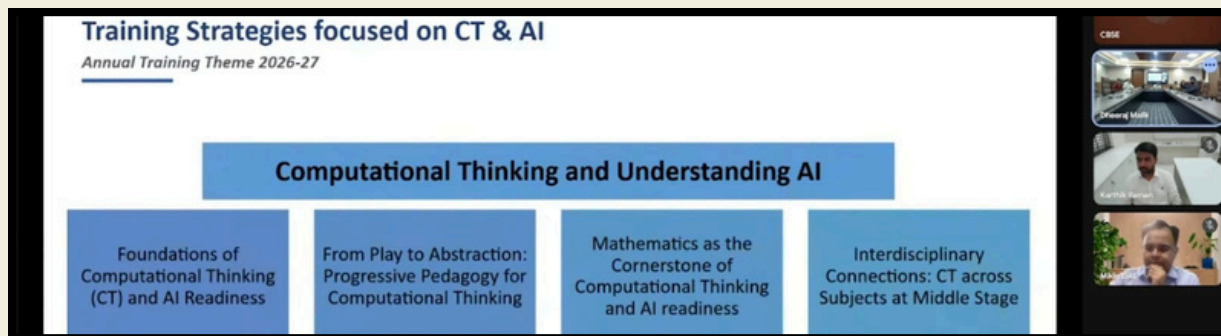
