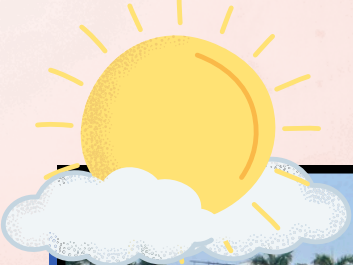
Success is not only about results, but about perseverance and integrity in the journey.

I wish you all clarity of mind, strength and spirit and outstanding success in your final exam.

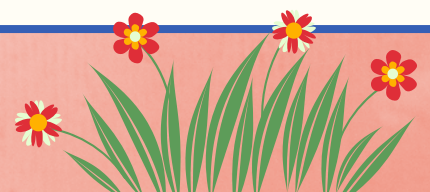

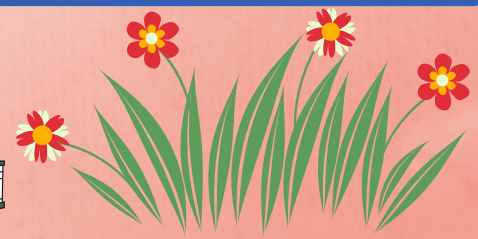
GOOD MANNERS ARE THE FOUNDATION OF A GREAT CHARACTER

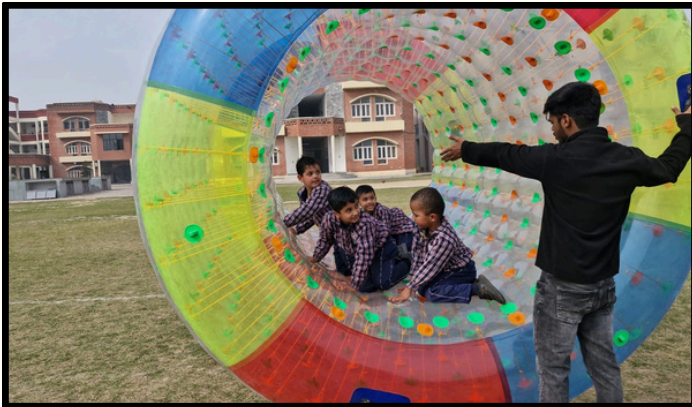


EARLY LEARNING BUILDS A STRONG FOUNDATION

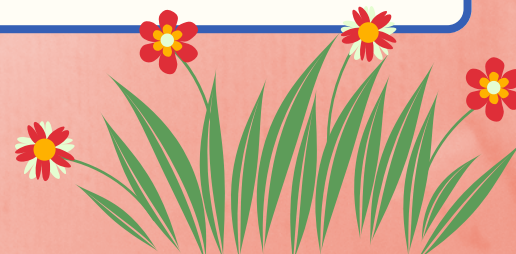


Adventure Camp

STAY ALERT, STAY SECURE

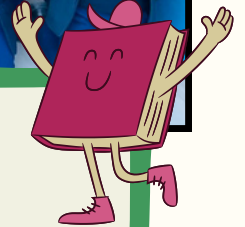

CLEANLINESS BEGINS WITH RESPONSIBILITY

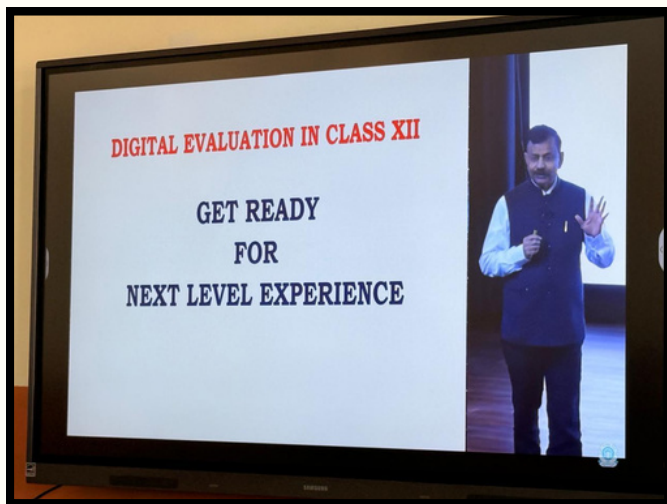

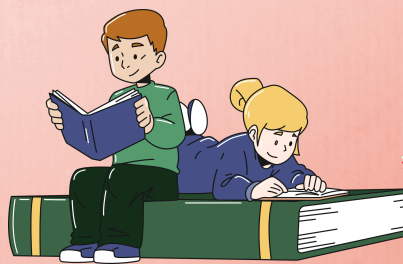
EXAMS ARE OPPORTUNITIES TO LEARN AND GROW

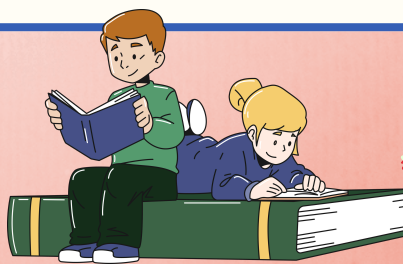


SilverZone English Olympiad Awards Ceremony

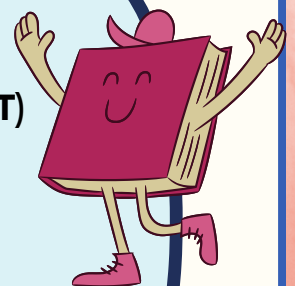
EDUCATION FLOURISHES WHEN SCHOOL AND HOME WALK TOGETHER
