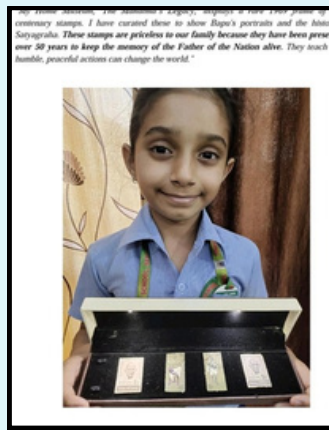
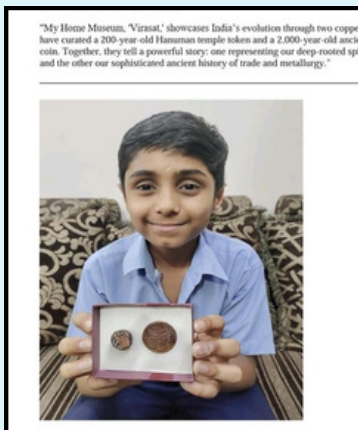


DRONA-ARJUN AWARD FELICITATION CEREMONY
