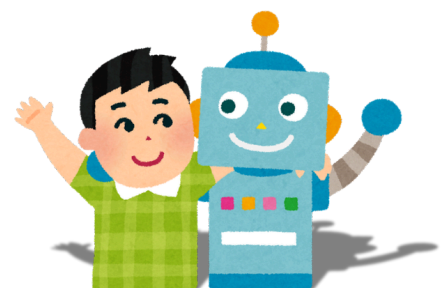

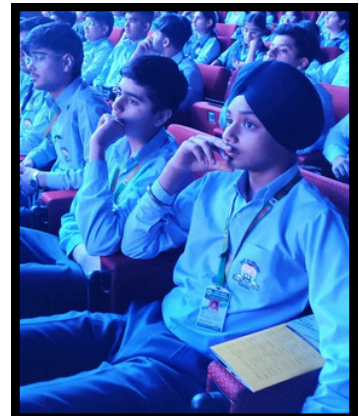
# BEYOND THE CLASSROOM

## UKG GRADUATION DAY CELEBRATION

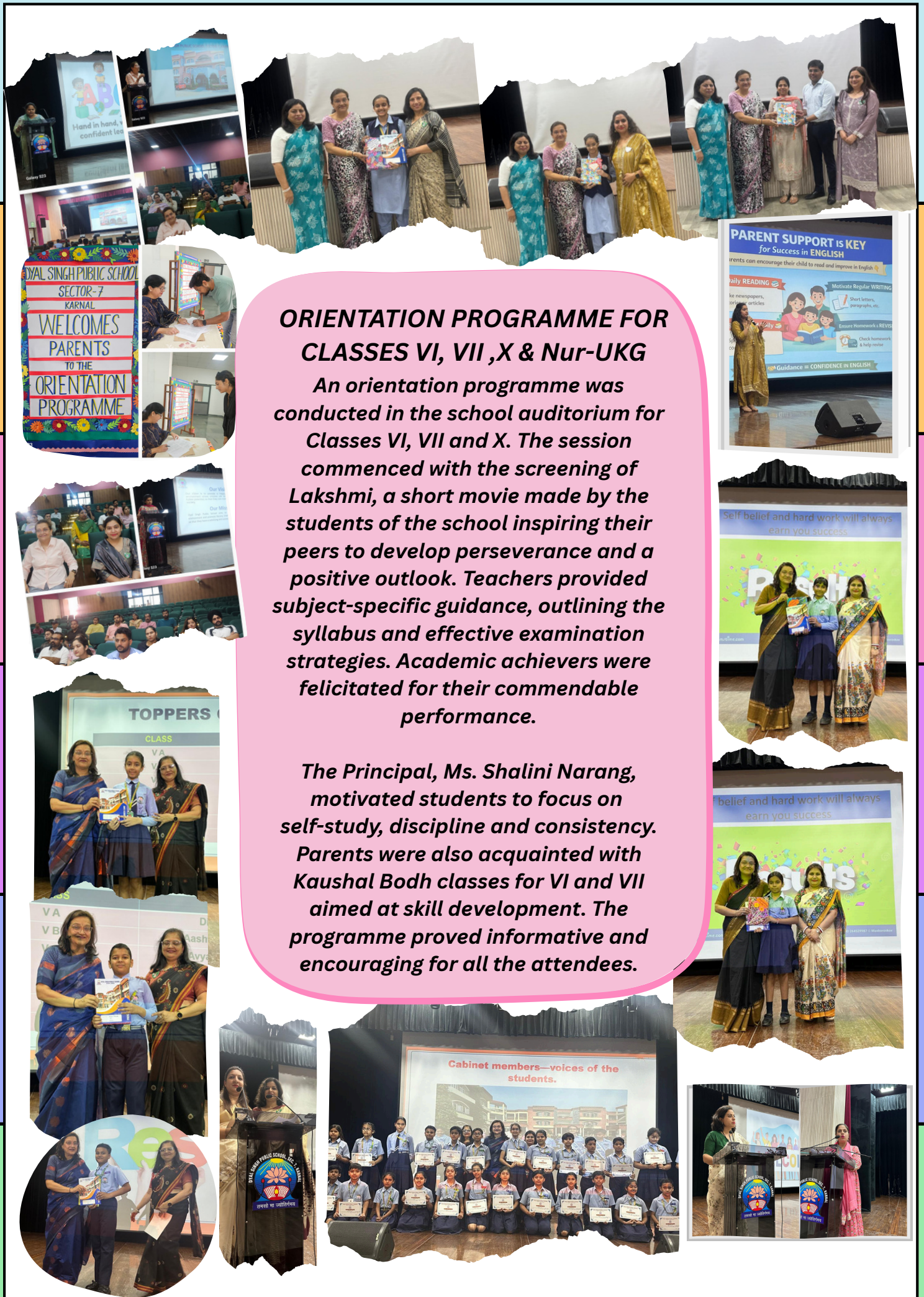

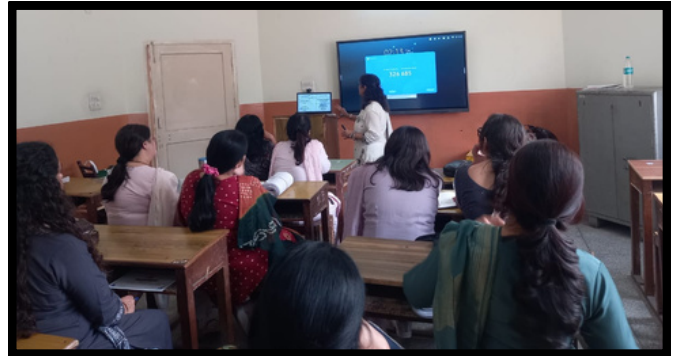

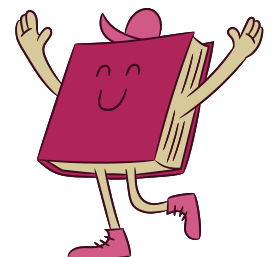
